



So You're interested in becoming a WSPC Docent?

1. How to Apply:
 - Fill out the online greeter application (available in February).
 - Send an email to volunteer@washingtonsquareparkconservancy.org expressing your interest in the program and attach your application.
2. Time Commitment:
 - Becoming a WSPC Docent requires participation in the program orientation. This includes lectures, workshops, and on-site tours, as well as required reading. A day-long orientation is offered in March/April
 - Volunteers are expected to serve a full season, which runs from April-October.
 - 2 shifts per month. Shifts are Saturdays and Sundays from 11am-2pm.
 - Additional trainings required to become a tour guide. Greeter training must be fully completed before continuing.
3. Fun Bonuses:
 - Insider knowledge about Washington Square Park and training from WSP experts.
 - Early access to WSPC schwag (water-bottles, hats, stickers, buttons, etc).
 - A nifty WSPC Volunteer ID and lanyard.
 - An invite to our volunteer thank you party.
